

NOTICE ON

INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CERAMICS MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION 2021

Appropriate authority of the Institute has decided to hold the membership examination of the Indian Institute of Ceramics for existing and new students in online mode in view of Covid-19 pandemic situation.

- a) The registration for the examination open. Interested candidates are requested to contact the Office of IIC.
- b) As no exams were conducted in 2020, the students who could not complete their papers in 2020, can sit for the exam this year to clear the examination.
- c) Eligible students for whom admit card would be issued after successful completion of form fill-up process, would be able to appear in the online examinations from their home/suitable place, with proper ambience of examination through the link available in the login. There should not be presence of additional personnel and other devices for appearing the examinations. However, they can keep blank pages and pen/pencil for rough work/calculation.
- d) For a 100 marks paper, 75% weightage on online written exam (of 50 marks) and 25% weightage on assessment of subject knowledge through online viva-voce will be given. A separate panel will assess the subject knowledge of student (25 marks) through an online viva-voce.
- e) For a 50 marks paper, 75% weightage on online written exam (of 25 marks) and 25% weightage on online viva voce on subject knowledge shall be given. A separate panel will assess the subject knowledge of student (20 marks) through an online viva-voce.
- f) Question pattern will be changed to short questions and MCQ type. For a 50 marks paper, 20 marks (1 mark x20) MCQ and 30 marks (3 marks x10) short answer type questions will be set.
- g) Time allotted writing exam of 50 marks paper is 90 min and that for 25 mark paper is 45 minutes. The question paper will be shared with the students 15 minutes before the exam and another 15 minutes will be given after the exam to scan and upload their answer scripts in the software platform.
- h) A mock test will be held one week before the exam to make the students familiar with the process.
- i) The practical examination may be held online where the students may be evaluated with practical projects/poster presentations by them. The topics and details for such examination will be shared with the students through online meet.
- j) The examination may tentatively start on 20th Dec 2021 and be held during 7-9 pm. The final schedule will be shared through the website of IIC.
- k) There would be technical support during the examinations. If any student is unable to appear in the online examinations due to device or connectivity issues etc, they are advised to get support from examination office well in advance.
- l) Appropriate technical measures are taken to prevent malpractice during examinations.
- m) Schedule for examination will be available in the examination portal/admit card.
